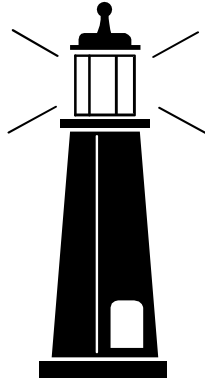

DAY ONE

Afternoon arrival in Duluth, MN

City Tour

One of the Duluth CVB's step-on guides will meet your group and narrate an exciting historic tour of the city from high atop the rocky hillside to the waterfront below.

Visit the **Lake Superior Maritime Visitor Center** in the Canal Park waterfront district. Intriguing exhibits about the Great Lakes shipping industry and life aboard the giant freighters. Located adjacent to the Aerial Lift Bridge.

Lunch on own in Canal Park – a variety of restaurants to choose from. Stroll the boardwalk, shop, watch ships as they enter the harbor.

Tour the **St. Louis County Heritage & Arts Center, (The Depot)** - Four floors to explore Duluth's history and heritage. Museums include the famous Lake Superior Railroad Museum.

Train Ride & Box Lunch on the **North Shore Scenic Railroad**; One-way train ride along the lakeshore and through the forests to Two Harbors, MN

Tour **Gooseberry Falls State Park** - Paved walkways to the upper and lower waterfalls and visit the interpretive center with gift shop and museum.

Tour and Film at **Split Rock Lighthouse**
Award-winning film and tour of this early 1900's lighthouse and keeper's home and an award-winning film.

Travel to **Lutsen/Tofte** area – Nestled against the Sawtooth Mountains and wrapped around Lake Superior's coast, this area offers a variety of activities in a spectacular setting.

Visit the **North Shore Commercial Fishing Museum** in Tofte.

Enjoy a ride on the Tram above the beautiful Sawtooth Mt. Range (Autumn colors are spectacular)

DAY FOUR

Breakfast – How about a hearty pancake breakfast and a tour of a maple syrup farm located on the Caribou Trail?

Travel to **Grand Marais**, MN – this fascinating harbor village is set on the shores of Lake Superior and features shopping, restaurants and unique lodging as well as year-round cultural opportunities.

Travel to **Grand Portage** and see the Grand Portage National Monument, featuring a reconstructed Northwest Company fur-trading post. Take the ferry to Isle Royale with its magnificent natural beauty.

Overnight in an historic lodge before heading home.

P S You can also do this in reverse and end up in Duluth. If schedule allows, the train will take you one-way to Duluth from Two Harbors.
