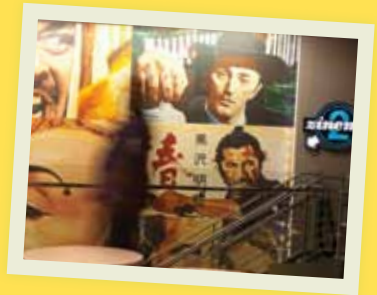


ART AS ORIGINAL AS ITS BIRTHPLACE
