

Remember, once the parade begins, do not operate in Duluth Harbor near the Aerial Lift Bridge. There will be law enforcement vessels clearing areas that are off limits to vessels not involved in the Parade of Sail.

Water Activities Calendar and Restrictions:

Waterside Viewing of the Parade of Ships (29 Jul 2010); parade 2-5 p.m. **All waters within 100 yards of any Tall Ship is a moving safety/security zone. All vessels are required to remain 100 yards from the Tall Ships. Duluth harbor entrance near the Lift Bridge and the harbor in front of the DECC will be restricted to the Tall Ships and their escort boats. There will be Law Enforcement vessels and escort vessels around the Tall Ships and in Duluth Harbor, please follow their instructions. Vessels can be contacted on Marine VHF-FM CH. 16.**

***Boating Safety
Do's and Don'ts***

Do come and enjoy yourselves!!

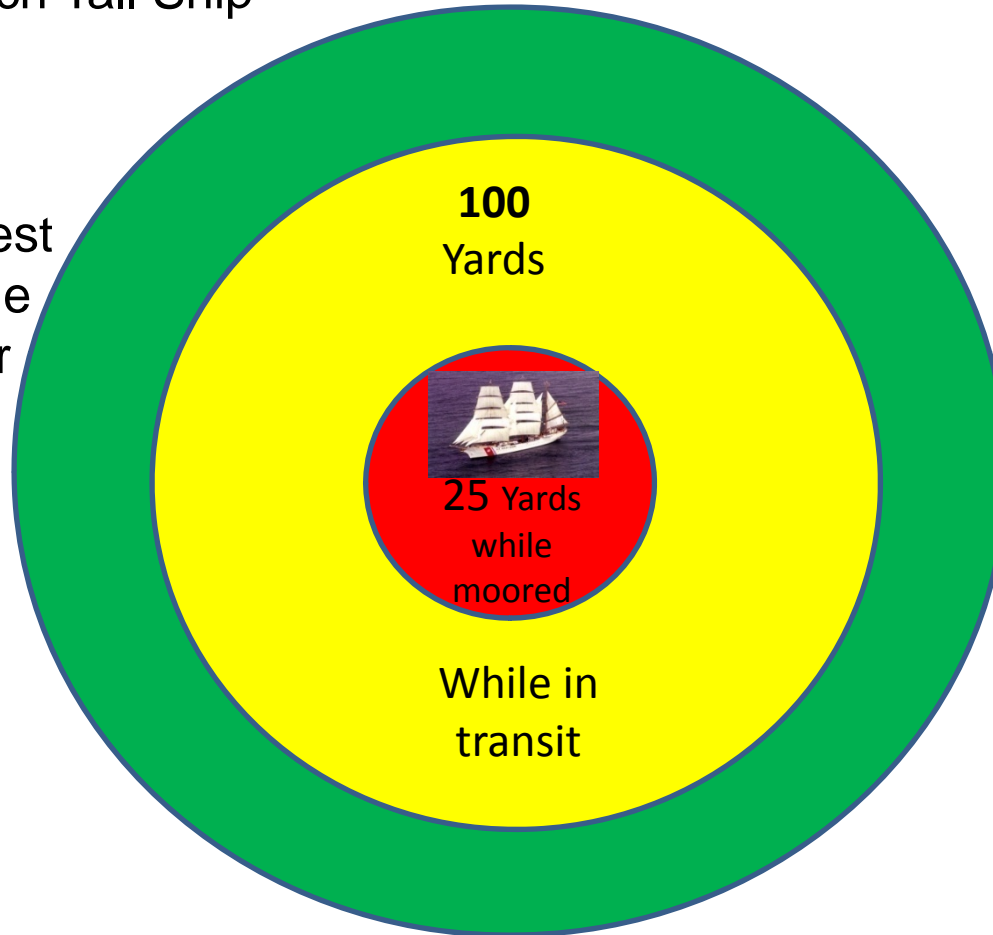
- DO** follow the directions of the on-scene patrol boats and escort boats with banners.
- DO** bring plenty of water, food, any required medications, sunscreen, hats, adequate fuel, and clothing for any weather.
- DO** retain your trash/sewage on board.
- DO** be considerate of other spectator boats; give way to deep draft vessels.
- DO** have a designated driver; drink responsibly.
- DO** use VHF Channel 16 to report on-board emergencies. For all else, use VHF Channel 9, the hailing frequency for the northeast U.S.
- DO** anchor in designated areas, outside the shipping channel.
- DO** watch out for other boats' anchor lines - stay clear of them.
- DO**, in restricted areas, transit at no-wake speeds; once anchored for the parade, remain so.
- DON'T** attempt to approach any Tall Ship or other vessel participating in the parade.
- DON'T** raft with other vessels at anchor or leave your boat unattended.
- DON'T** expect non-emergency services to be available once the parade starts.

Safety/Security Zone for Tall Ships 2010 in the Great Lakes

Unrestricted vessel movements if your vessel is greater than 100 yards from each Tall Ship

Vessels may request permission from the Patrol Commander to enter the 100 yard safety/security zone

Any vessels within 100 yards must operate their vessels at the minimum speed necessary to maintain a safe course (no wake speed)



Any vessel authorized to enter this safety/security zone must still remain at least 25 yards from any Tall Ship.

When Tall Ships are moored and navigational constraints require you to pass within 25 yards of a Tall Ship, your vessel should remain as close to middle of channel as practical and at minimum speed.
